It was established in 1974 by a group of three women who were unemployed trying to fight poverty and providing for their families through making pots and exchanging them for food and clothes.

After some time, two women passed on. One of them was Sarah Munyai who saw a need of teaching other women how to make pots. She then invited 25 other women to come work with her. This led to the growth of the pottery and women were able to provide for their families.

Lot of children were bread from clay pots sales and they even went to universities. Sarah Munyai led the women until she passed on in 2017. After her passing 5 youth joined the women in pottery and stil making pots to date.
